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So what has PEVOA accomplished?

During the past 2 years, PEVOA has standardized the Pilot/Escort Driver Certification program in 6 States and is currently working with 4 additional States that currently require Driver Certification.

11 States are currently in various stages of development with Pilot/Escort Driver Certification programs and PEVOA is making a concerted effort to work with each of them to promote uniformity.

Flagging is a major issue that is being faced by many Pilot/Escort Drivers. PEVOA has been working hard to change State Rules and Regulations to include language that will provide legal authority to control traffic. Our success is noted with 2 States now having the language that provides this authority within Rules and Regulations.

Automobile and General Liability Insurance for the Pilot/Escort Industry has been another issue that PEVOA has been working very hard to find solutions for our members. This has been one of the most challenging and difficult issues that our Association has tackled and we are now seeing success for our members. Recently we have been able to find a solution for the General Liability insurance issue and can now say that our members have access to this type of Insurance that covers the type of work operations that a Pilot/Escort undertakes. We hope that within the next couple of months, that we have additional options for Automobile Insurance carriers that will be willing to provide this type of insurance.

Working with the Federal Agencies and various other entities, PEVOA has been working on a public awareness effort to educate the general public as to what Pilot/Escorts are all about. Soon, PEVOA will undertake a deployment of mailing CD's to Drivers Education Programs across the country. PEVOA is also working with State Agencies to develop a Public Broadcast Announcements that will be utilized on the public air-waves, again to educate the motoring public about Pilot/Escorts.
